POSITION SUMMARY & RESPONSIBILITIES

Our team is currently seeking a Geologist I based in Denver, CO to provide technical expertise on various projects located within North America as assigned.

As a Geologist I at Dahrouge, you will be provided with supervision and guidance for your professional development. This role entails a significant field component and may involve work in remote areas with a yearly travel expectation of 50-70%. You will collaborate with a team to support ongoing geological exploration, undertaking various tasks including:

- Conducting geophysical and geochemical surveys.
- Engaging in surface prospecting activities.
- Supervising drills and setting up drill sites.
- Assisting with project preparation and logistics.
- Processing core samples, which includes geotechnical logging, geological logging, sampling, core photography, specific gravity measurements, core cutting, and sample shipping.
- Undertaking geological mapping, creating cross-sections, and interpreting geological data.
- Assisting with database entry, review, and providing support for geological modeling.
- Participating in data acquisition and compilation.
- Assisting in updating schedules, project budgets, and drill tracking.
- Contributing to the writing of comprehensive status reports for senior management, regulatory agencies, and third parties.

REQUIREMENTS / CERTIFICATIONS

- A bachelor’s degree in geology from an accredited university.
- A fundamental understanding of geology.
- Experience in core/RC chip logging is preferred.
- Exposure to different types of drilling and drilling supervision is advantageous.
- Drill core logging and material sampling with adherence to best-practice QA/QC protocols;
- Recognition and compliance with regulatory and Health, Safety, and Environmental guidelines;
- Ability to track project metrics (drilling rates, costs, etc.) with guidance.
- Pursuit of a geologist in training designation from an accredited organization is required.
- Experience with industry standard software packages such as ArcGIS, QGIS, Leapfrog, Vulcan, Microsoft Office, etc. is considered an asset;
