At Dahrouge, John has managed early to midstage exploration and drilling programs, both ground-based and helicopter-supported. These have included gold projects in Northwest Territories and Yukon; carbonatite-hosted rare metal and rare earth projects in British Columbia and Quebec; spodumene-bearing pegmatites in Manitoba, Quebec, and the Northwest Territories, as well as brine- and clay-hosted lithium deposits in Nevada, and base-metals in Alaska. He supervised three seasons of drilling to evaluate metallurgical coal in the Alberta foothills (2013-2017). In 2012, he was co-manager of a large, helicopter-supported Ni-PGE drill program in Cape Smith, Quebec. He has written numerous (43-101) technical reports for properties belonging to various clients in Alberta, Columbia, Saskatchewan, Nevada, Argentina, Yukon, and the Northwest Territories.
